

# I'm Jailbroken, Now What?

Have you had a friend jailbreak your iPhone, and not no what to do with it now? Then this is the guide for you. This guide will show you the basics of what you can do after you are jailbroken, great apps and more. This guide WILL NOT show you how to jailbreak or aid you in the process of jailbreaking. After you jailbreak you should be aware that, although jailbreaking is not currently illegal, apple does not want you to do this, so if you ever have to send it in make sure you un-jailbreak. (This will be in the guide) I hope you learn something from this guide.

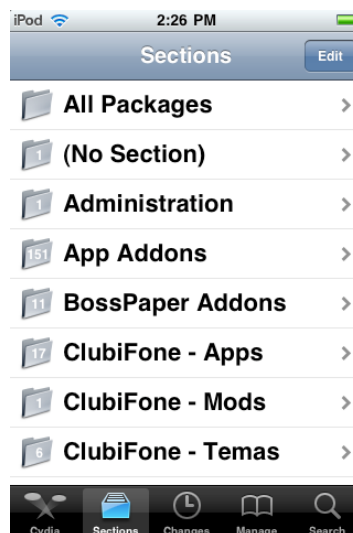
## Basics

You should have noticed one or two new icons in you springboard, most will have cydia, cydia and icy, or just icy. (running 2.2.1 or 3.0) For those with old 1.X firmware you will have installer. (To the right is the cydia icon, then the icy icon and then the installer icon. Cydia is the most popular of all the installers and has the most packages available in it. Icy is newer, faster and skinable but I have found that not all packages will install right with icy. Installer is for all the people running 1.X firmware's and above, although it is possible to get on all other firmware's. I suggest having more then one installer, in case cydia crashes, you might have to reinstall. In this guide I will only be providing information on the cydia installer, because it is the installer most people will use, but once you can figure out cydia, icy and installer will not be hard to learn how to use.



## How to Use Cydia

Cydia is very easy to use once you no some basics. In this part I will be showing you screen shots of the homepage, sections, and how to add sources, and how to install packages.





The top left screenshot is of the homepage, the top right is sections where you can download games, utilities, toys, themes and more! The bottom right is the main page of the manage tab, you can add sources and configure packages. The bottom right page is the main page of sources. Sources are basically websites that have cydia packages in them. To Add a source click Edit>Add>"Source">Add Source. Then your source will be added. There are many sources built in, but here are some more I can suggest.

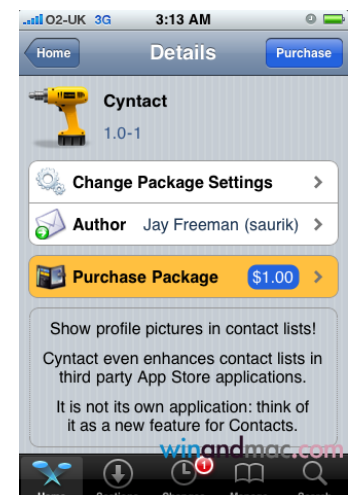

If you still have more trouble adding sources search youtube for: Add a cydia source. There will be plenty of tutorials. Adding sources to installer and icy are much the same.

You can search for packages or find them under, sections. To install a package tap it, then in the upper right click install>confirm. (Note all packages have icons, ie. Winterboard themes, sbsettings).

## Cydia Store

Cydia store is brand NEW! You can get to it on the main cydia page or searching for packages. Not all are listed under the homepage though. Now there even are some themes that are available. You can pay with pay pal or amazon payment. The packages range from games to utilities. More packages are added each day. There is not copy protection on any of these



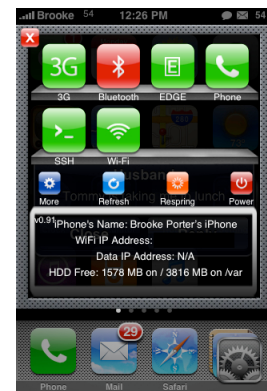
games, so it is up to the purchaser that the app is not cracked. If you want your app to be added you can email Jay Freeman to get added. Hosting is free, unlike the app store which is 100 dollars a year.

## Some Suggest Packages

- SBSettings: This is great and also needed. Change brightness, toggle different options and more! To get this app open simply swipe the status bar.
- Winterboard: This is a great app to allow you to theme your ipod.
- Emulators: Some are NES, SNES, GENESIS, GB, GBA, TubroGrafx 16
- Search google for some more!

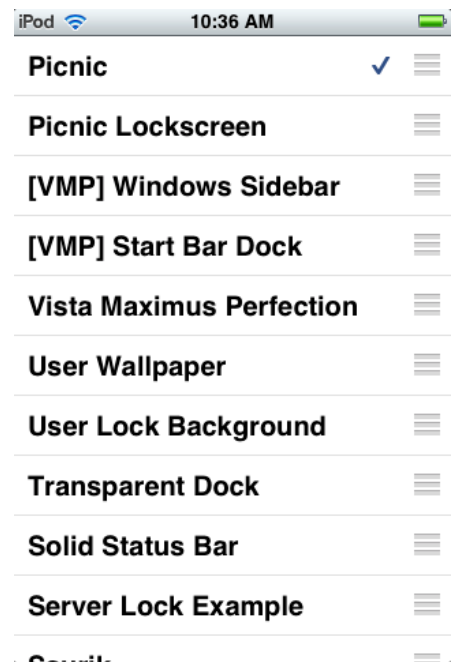
## SBSettings

SBSettings is almost a must have for all of those with a jailbroken iPhone or iPod Touch. You can place your most used toggels in the built in dock. (They are the icons in the dock to the right. Some examples are 3G, Edge, Phone, SSH Wifi. You can toggle these off to save battery. You can also change the brightness, and other things real fast. You can also see how much space you have left on your hd. To exit this app simply hit the home button or the red x in the upper left.



## Winterboard

This is a theme app for iphone and ipod touch. I always getting questions how I changed my wallpaper, dock background and more! Install this app by searching for it, then search cydia for themes. Cydia is full of them and there is plenty. Download the theme, then go into winterboard and select the theme. It is also very easy to make your own themes, simply search youtube for some tutorials. Check out some of the themes I made: <http://jshome.webs.com>. This almost everyone I know has this app if they are jailbroken.



# Emulators

One of the best part of being jailbroken is having emulators. Emulators are basically apps that duplicate the functions of old consoles. The game screen is on top, and the control pad is on the bottom half. The emulators that are available are NES (2.X firmware), NES 3 (3.X firmware), some more are, snes4iphone, gameboy4iphone, genesis4iphone, temper4iphone, mame4iphone and gpsPhone (GBA, cydia store, 5.99)

Emulators are great but are probably the hardest use. The easiest thing is to add this source: <http://apt.123locker.com>, it has NES, GBA and GENESIS roms. Simply go to sections and then go to games and you can add the rom packages. You can only download these roms though. If you want to have more roms you can follow the guide below, or go to zottd.com for more detailed info.

## How to install Roms to Emulators

Roms are basically games, and you can download them from a number of sites, simply google search roms. Download the roms you want then, unzip them. To learn how to install simply go to this site and follow the directions. <http://www.zottd.com/wiki/index.php/SSH> This will teach you how to ssh your roms. SSH is transferring them.

That's the basics, explore cydia, zottd.com, and other jailbroken sites to gain more knowledge about jailbreak features.
